A teleconference meeting of the Board of Directors of the Central Delta Water Agency was convened at 9:30 a.m. at the office of the Agency, 235 East Weber Avenue, Stockton, California.

The first item of business was approval of the Minutes of the August 8, 2023 meeting. After review.

It was reported that DWR was proceeding with the latest wave of entry permits consisting of 10 to 12 new filings.

Water right curtailment litigation is moving forward with preliminary motions.

On Legislation SB 389 was moving forward without changes suggested by those opposed. SB 88 on water right reporting is still in play.

The Alternative Compliance Plan was proceeding satisfactorily. On Delta levee program funding, \$37 million of existing bond funding was apparently located for special projects.

EPA is apparently investigating the propriety of water quality standards and the disproportionate impact on disadvantaged communities.

Thereafter, there being no further business to come before the meeting the meeting was adjourned.
