The first item of business were the Minutes of the July 19, 2022 meeting. After review,

On legislation nothing new was reported

As previously reported water use reports for the water year October 2021 through September 2022 reports are due February 1, 2023 and it is expected that the CDWA and SDWA Delta ACP based on OpenET will be operational.

Enhanced reporting for large diversions is continuing at twice a month.

On Tunnel related Temporary Permits it was reported that DWR was proceeding with additional entries and it appears that many more are planned. As each new TEP is undertaken the case is joined to the already adjudicated cases wherein the judge is not willing to accept new argument of already determined issues by the newly added defendant. It was recommended that filing fees and contribution towards attorney fees not be charged to newly added parties since the opportunity for change is limited but the rights of the individual need to be preserved in the event the CEQA case and/or appeal are successful. Second Director George Biagi Jr. unanimously approved the waiver of filing and attorney fees as proposed.

A report was given on the status of the Delta Stewardship Council Independent Science Board review of the methodology for determining SWP and CVP ability to meet water quality standards.

On levee programs it was reported that DWR stated their plan to solicit for special levee projects in a yet to be determined amount.

The Amended GSP for the Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Sub-basin was approved by all GSAs and submitted.

It was announced that the Board was going into a brief closed session to discuss personnel matters.

After closed session it was announced that no action was taken.

Thereafter, there being no further business to come before the meeting the meeting was adjourned.
